I achieve a modest scale of success at a time when red tape and dysfunction were at their greatest. I followed up on that effort by securing rehabilitation grants for several of the tarped homes, as well as hosting a grants clinic to assist other qualified homeowners to apply. Few knew about this grant program and the application period was short.

Since moving to Carrollton in 2001, I have been involved in many informal efforts to help our neighbors solve issues. When I first moved to New Orleans in 2000, I worked for JazzFest and a United Way nonprofit. Through those jobs and my work during Katrina, I met many local leaders all over the city.

Professionally, I am a federal environmental/historic specialist and handle compliance for several high profile projects.
